am not a person convicted of any offence punishable by imprisonment for a term of 6 months or longer, unless he has received a free pardon or has served his sentence or otherwise suffered the penalty imposed upon him.

INFORMATION FOR CANDIDATES

Candidates and Nominators should read this sheet carefully

- (1) Nomination forms must be lodged with the Board Secretary by close of nominations at **5.00pm, Friday 25 August 2023**, and should be addressed to:

- (2) Every candidate must be nominated by five (5) persons who are registered on the Roll of Beneficiaries for Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua and be 18 years or older.
- (3) Persons nominating a candidate must be adult registered beneficiaries of Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua, and be eligible to vote in the Takiwā for which that candidate is seeking election. Candidates should check with the Board Secretary to determine if they have properly nominated.
- (4) Each nomination should be accompanied by a candidate profile (attached) and a passport-sized colour photo. Candidates should be aware that this information will be made publicly available, including posting the information on the Te Rūnanga o Ngāti Whātua website and/or social media pages, and included with voting papers.
- (5) If only one (1) valid nomination is received for the Ōrākei Takiwā, then that one (1) candidate will be declared duly elected. If two (2) or more valid nominations are received for the Ōrākei Takiwā, an election will be conducted by a postal and online ballot of persons registered to vote for that Takiwā.
- (6) The candidate must sign the form to show his/her consent to the nomination. Failure to do so will make the nomination invalid.
- (7) The candidate may, at any time, withdraw his/her nomination by written notice to the Board Secretary at: info@electionservices.co.nz
- (8) Each candidate may assign **one scrutineer** to view the counting of votes. This is to be in writing, and to be arranged with the Secretary of the Board.

Candidate: This is the person who wants his/her name to be put forward for the Board member vacancy.

Nominators: These are the members of the Takiwā who are registered on the Roll of Beneficiaries and are 18 years or older and are nominating the candidate.
